Rx Outreach Launches Free Medication Program

St. Louis, Mo, March 10, 2025 – Rx Outreach, the nation's largest nonprofit mail-order pharmacy headquartered in St. Louis, has launched the Fill the Gap Prescription Assistance Program, a formulary of free medications to eligible individuals in the greater St. Louis region. Rx Outreach believes everyone deserves barrier-free access to the medications they need to be healthy.

To qualify for the Fill the Gap free medication program, patients must be uninsured for the drugs requested, 55 to 65 years old, and live in St. Louis City, St. Louis, St. Charles, Jefferson, Franklin, Madison, Monroe, or St. Clair Counties. A patient's household income must be at or below 300% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL); For 2025, the 300% FPL is \$46,950 for a household of one and \$96,450 for a household of four. Fill the Gap Program currently provides medication related to cardiovascular, diabetes, and asthma/allergy diseases with monthly support to eligible patients for an enrollment of 12 months.

Fill the Gap is a pilot program, funded by the Seniors Community Revitalization & Development Fund, launched by the [Community Health Commission of Missouri](#) in partnership with [Deaconess Foundation](#), committed to strengthening public health, promoting transparency, and addressing the needs of residents aged 55 and older.
